

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR CREW OF EXILES BY NEAL HOLTSCHULTE

QUESTION 1

Did the book appeal to you? Why or why not?

QUESTION 2

Were parts of the story confusing? Which parts? How do other readers explain or interpret those parts?

QUESTION 3

Who was your favorite character and why?

QUESTION 4

One theme of the story is how to cope with the benefits and drawbacks of existing in a body that one did not choose for one's self. Did the story lead you to reflect on your relationship with your own body? How so?

QUESTION 5

Another theme is isolation, especially self-imposed isolation. How does this theme manifest in the story and how does it relate to modern life?

QUESTION 6

In fiction writing, there is a concept called "the lie the character believes," referring to a misheld belief a character holds at the beginning of the story. Eventually, the lie falls apart, which allows the character to grow as a person. Does each character believe a lie? If so, what do they believe and how does their belief change over time?

QUESTION 7

Transhumanism is a philosophical and intellectual movement which advocates the enhancement of the human condition by developing and making widely available technologies to enhance longevity and cognition. -Wikipedia

How do you feel about the idea of transhumanism? Does it appeal to you?

QUESTION 8

What does it mean to be human? What are the most noble attributes of humanity?

QUESTION 9

Fife and Beryl contrast directly, but Ohnsy and Nesh are also quite different. How do Ohnsy and Nesh challenge Fife and Beryl? (And how do they challenge each other?)

QUESTION 10

Is Fife a naïve gamer or is she wise and heroic? How much do motives count or are actions the only things that matter?

QUESTION 11

Virtual reality and other constructed realities are prominent sci-fi elements. How does control over reality (or lack thereof) contribute to the story?

QUESTION 12

Do you have a favorite passage or quote? Why is it your favorite?

QUESTION 13

Did you notice any similarities to other books? What did *Crew of Exiles* remind you of?

QUESTION 14

Are there any themes that you identified within the novel that have not been mentioned? What are they?

QUESTION 15

Did you have any expectations going into this book? What were they and did they turn out to be accurate?
